**REFUND POLICY:** If you withdraw prior to April 1, your deposit less \$150.00 processing charge will be returned to you with your written and signed notification of cancellation. On or after April 1, all deposits are non-refundable. This also applies to registrations received on or after April 1. After April 1, with written and signed notice, camp fee, less \$250.00 deposit per session enrolled, will be returned to a coach who withdraws up to 30 days prior to their camp session. There is no refund if cancellation is within 30 days of their coach session. No refund will be made for a coach who withdraws at any time after arriving at camp. There is no reduction in fees for late arrival and early departure.

(a/k/a IGC) granting permission to use the gymnastic equipment and facilities located at [100 Gymnastics Way](#), Stroudsburg, PA 18360-8137, for practice and training, do hereby release IGC, its officers, employees, and agents from any and all liability, claims, demands, controversies, damages, actions and causes of action which may occur by reason of injury, death, loss of services or consortium, property damage and any and all other loss and damages of any kind and nature sustained by or resulting in the undersigned from the use of said gymnastics equipment and facilities. Participation in gymnastics activities involves motion, rotation and height in a unique environment and as such carries with it a reasonable assumption of risk. WARNING: CASTROPHIC INJURY, PARALYSIS, AND EVEN DEATH CAN RESULT FROM IMPROPER CONDUCT OF GYMNASTICS ACTIVITY. The undersigned certifies that the inherent risks of gymnastics participation are adequately appreciated and that the said participation is done on a strictly voluntary basis.

The undersigned has been or understands competitive gymnastics and is fully aware of his or her capabilities and limitations. The undersigned agrees that he or she will not attempt any tricks (skills) or routines which he or she has not been trained to perform safely.

The undersigned is currently a professional [coach](#) and has experience coaching and can provide a USAG # [\(or proof of professional membership from another organization or country\)](#) which is required to attend.

This release shall bind the undersigned, their heirs, administrators and assigns. It is agreed that any dispute or cause of action arising between the parties, whether out of this agreement or otherwise, can only be brought in the Pennsylvania Court of Common Pleas located in Monroe County, Pennsylvania, and shall be construed in accordance with the laws of Pennsylvania.

## Welcome to IGC !

### FAQ's for VISITING COACHES

#### **WHEN DO I CHECK-IN?**

Check-in is between 12:30pm and 2:00pm on Sunday. Visiting coaches meet with the Gym Director at 4:00pm on the staff patio. If you are going to be late, please notify us as soon as possible.

#### **WHAT SHOULD I BRING?**

Leave your luggage in your car until you check in as you will be driving to the visiting coaches' house. You should bring bedding and pillow - towels - personal items - sneakers - summer casual clothes. Coin operated laundry facilities are located on the camp grounds, and detergent is sold in the canteen.

#### **I AM BRINGING MY GYMNASTS WITH ME. IS THERE ANYTHING I NEED TO KNOW?**

The parent/guardian of each gymnast must complete the Pick-Up Authorization through their "My IGC Login" under Forms and Documents for any camper who is leaving the grounds or departing from camp with someone other than the camper's parent/guardian. The Pick-Up Authorization form must be completed online before check-in on Sunday. Remember, campers are not permitted to leave the grounds during the week.

We recommend downloading the 2012 Parent-Camper Guide from our website for more general information.

#### **WILL I BE STAYING IN THE CABIN WITH MY GYMNASTS?**

Our visiting coaches stay in our Visiting Coaches' House. Gymnasts are not allowed in coaches' housing nor are coaches allowed in camper cabins. There is plenty of time, however, to meet with campers in common areas during meals and evening recreation time between 9-10 PM.

#### **WILL I BE ABLE TO WORK WITH MY GYMNASTS?**

Because of insurance, visiting coaches are only allowed to coach their gymnasts during Open Workout with designated IGC Staff.

#### **AM I ABLE TO WORK OUT WHILE I AM AT IGC?**

If you are planning on working out, you will need to complete a General Release form prior to arrival and provide us with your medical insurance coverage. A copy of the front and back of your insurance card can be attached to our General Release form. You will be working out under Abie & Phil's supervision.

## A Note for the Visiting Coaches

A visiting coach can have an enormous impact on the experience of campers at IGC. It is important that you acknowledge that this impact can be both positive and negative.

We have learned over the last 40 years how to ensure that campers with visiting coaches have the most positive and genuine experience. It is simple: visiting coaches should allow campers to experience camp as if they (the visiting coaches) were not here.

Camp is a time for your gymnasts to enjoy great facilities, new coaches, and an awesome environment. It is also a time for them to be cared for by the wonderful staff at IGC. This time can be used as a chance for coaches to take a break from their regular schedules and develop some new skills while relaxing in a place that caters to your needs. So please, while you are at IGC, leave the management of your campers to us.

To help you understand what we mean we have created a list of Do's and Don'ts based upon our most recent experiences with your peers. We hope they are helpful.

### **DO**

- Interact with your gymnasts at open gym
- Say hi to them and encourage them to fully enjoy the camp experience
- Discuss the day briefly with them between 9pm and 10pm
- Bring any camper or camp issues directly to a member of the Head Counseling Team

### **DO NOT**

- Allow campers to see or use your cell phone. It should not be able to be seen by any camper. Please do not give your cell phone to a camper
- Get involved in camper issues at all, refer all problems and questions to a member of the Head Counseling Team
- Counsel campers unless you have been asked to get involved by the Head Counselor
- Get involved in cabin assignments or cabin issues
- Discuss homesickness with any camper
- Force your campers to go to open work out
- Let campers sit on your lap
- Pull their teeth out
- Give them medication or recommend medication or treatment
- Give them money to buy things at the canteen for you
- Sit with your campers at any meal time
- Allow your campers to sit with you at meal times
- Go in, around or near the cabin
- Abuse the cabin counselor or any staff member

At IGC the entire staff are dedicate to ensuring the best possible experience for all of our campers. If there is anything that you need, want, or have an issue with, please bring it to our attention for further discussion.

## **IGC Internet Social Network and Blog Agreement**

This Agreement is between International Gymnastics School-Camp, Inc. ("IGC"), and the below signed Visiting Coach, ("Guest"), regarding guidelines for Social Networking, personal website use, Blogging, and other forms of broad media communication while employed at IGC, hereinafter ("SNWB").

### **Background**

IGC maintains various SNWB's in connection with its business activities. IGC respects the right of employees and Visiting Coaches to use SNWB's as a medium of self-expression. However, if a Visiting Coach chooses to identify him/herself as a guest of IGC on such Internet venues, some readers of such SNWB's may view you as a representative or spokesperson of IGC. In light of this possibility, IGC requires a condition of participation in the Visiting Coaches' Program that Coaches observe guidelines and standards when referring to IGC, its programs, facilities, campers, staff members, employees and Visiting Coaches.

### **Standards**

Visiting Coaches must be respectful in all communications related to or referencing IGC, its campers, staff members and employees when corresponding on, or using, any SNWB.

### **Guidelines and Prohibitions**

Visiting Coaches shall not contribute to SNWB, do wall postings, tweets, or other forms of electronic communication for broad distribution while a guest at IGC. Visiting Coaches may use private messaging or email directly, but not for general distribution. Visiting Coaches must not use obscenities, profanity, or other vulgar language; nor use an SNWB to disparage IGC, campers, staff members, employees and other Visiting Coaches of IGC. Visiting Coaches must not use an SNWB to harass, bully, or intimidate other staff members, employees, Coaches or campers. Behaviors that constitute harassment and bullying include, but are not limited to, comments that are derogatory with respect to race, religion, gender, sexual orientation, color, or disability; sexually suggestive, humiliating, or demeaning comments; and threats to stalk, haze, or physically injure another staff member, or camper. Visiting Coaches must not post pictures of campers on an SNWB without written permission of IGC. Visiting Coaches must not post pictures of staff members, or other visiting coaches on an SNWB without obtaining written permission of IGC. Note: The use of the IGC name or logo, in any manner, on any SNWB is strictly prohibited, without the expression permission of IGC. Visiting Coaches shall be responsible and liable to IGC and indemnify IGC against any lawful damages caused by Coaches violation of this Agreement.
